

# Investing for Success

## This funding will be used to:

The school focus areas for 2019 are:

- Embedding Curriculum;
- Student Support and Engagement;
- Staff Development and Support; and
- Community Engagement.

Targets for the above focus areas include:

- 100% of teaching staff using the Australian Curriculum for all Learning Areas;
- 100% of students being marked on a 5 point scale;
- 100% of students on an Individual Curriculum Plan (ICP) achieving a 'C' or better;
- 90% of all students achieving a 'C' or better in English, Maths and Science;
- 90% student attendance for 2019;
- 50% reduction in number of students below 85% attendance;
- 20% reduction in the number of major behaviour incidents;
- 25% increase in positive behaviour referrals;
- 100% of staff engaged in professional development;
- 100% of all areas in the School Opinion survey either increase or are maintained; and
- 80% of parents are using electronic communication with the school including Dojo, QParents and Skoolbag.

## Our initiatives include:

- Purchasing a Local Relief Teacher (LRT) to ensure that there is regular and familiar replacement staff available for student continuity and support.
- Purchasing an additional class teacher to allow for mid-year numbers increases and to promote smaller classes.
- Purchasing online literacy and numeracy programs Prep-Year 6 that can be worked on at home and at school to increase student engagement and resources available to parents.
- Purchasing additional teacher aide time to drive Home Reading programs in Prep-Year 3 classes.
- Purchasing additional readers for both guided and home reading.
- The development of Home Grown Professional Development (PD) to support the targeted needs of staff through their Developing Performance Plan (DPP) conversations.
- Enhancement of parental communication through Skoolbag, Dojo and use of school website.

\* Funding amount estimated on 2018 data. Actual funding will be determined after 2019 enrolment data are finalised. Actual expenditure may be varied due to changes in finalised 2019 enrolment data and student learning needs.


