Our initiatives include

- Developing effective pedagogical practices across Australian Curriculum, in teaching Reading.
- Continuing to develop and embed a whole school, research-based approach for inclusion, to meet the academic, social and emotional needs of all students.
- Continuing to embed the use of data to inform teaching and resource allocation.
- Improving community partnerships.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- 1. Employ a full-time additional Deputy Principal to support the implementation of Australian Curriculum and embedding effective pedagogical practices. (\$80,000)
- 2. Employ an Indigenous Teacher Aide (3 days a week for the year) to support community relationships, improvements attendance in First Nations Students and support both the inclusion and reading agendas. (\$35,297)
- 3. Purchase additional teacher aide time to drive the school's inclusion agenda and support Students with Disability(s) who come under the NCCD. (\$60,000)
- 4. Purchase additional Speech Language Pathologist [SLP] time (1 day a week) to support language development in the early years. (\$20,000)
- 5. Providing teachers with time to support their own wellbeing as well as develop year plans. (\$20,000)
- 6. Professional Development for staff to improve pedagogical approaches, implement reading across the curriculum, and ensure an effective transition to a fully inclusive school. (\$60,000)
